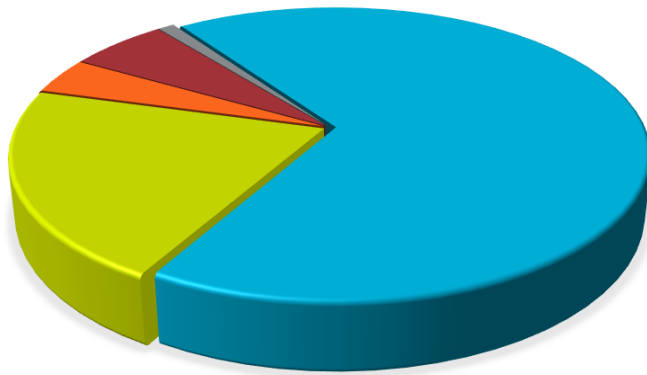
Financials

In total, the contributions of volunteers, homeowners, and the institution's operations by Habitat affiliates across the state of Tennessee amounted to more than \$107 million in economic activity and 1,234 jobs.



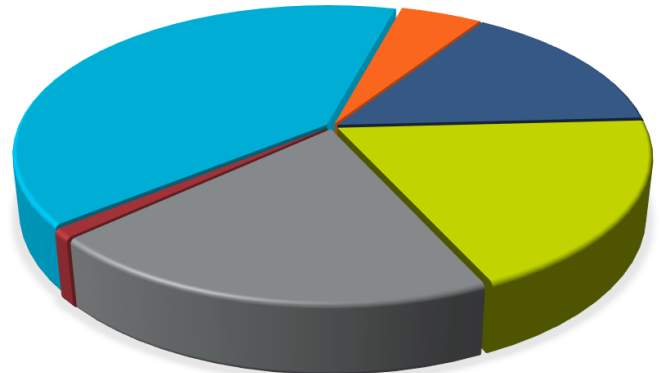
Average Home Cost
